

"We knocked on the door, but the thing's still closed," Greenwood Coach Mike Loudermilk said. "They did what they had to do and the Avon girls did what they had to and they won. Our kids rose to the occasion, but we're still that second athlete's score in each event away. That depth is what Avon had and they deserved to win it."

Greenwood's Mariah Owen won both hurdle races to pace the Woodmen, while Heather Meiser took a pair of seconds, despite her best times of the year in the 100 and 200 meters.

Franklin's Julie Mashino was also a double winner as the senior won the shot put (32'7") and discus (93'7").

"Julie had an outstanding meet," Coach Tim Leonard said. "To take two firsts in any event is tough, but she came here ready to do well and just had a really fine meet."

Overall, the Johnson County team ran better in the conference meet

than in the county.

"Given the circumstances (weather), we had some girls turn in some very good performances and as a team, we had a better week this week and I'm proud of that," Leonard said.

The girls meet wasn't without its controversy, as the 400-meter relay race was started at the wrong position and had to be run again about an hour later.

The firt time through, Plainfield won with a school record time, but Greenwood came back to capture the second running. Whiteland finished second in both races.

A pair of individual sectional titles by Center Grove seniors Jenny Dray and Julie Borns leads 16 Johnson County individuals and four relay teams into the regional round of the girls track state tournament.

All six county schools have at least one individual advancing and half the schools have a sectional champion.

"That's the way it should be," Center Grove Coach Carol Turney said.
"I think Johnson County was well

represented tonight."

Center Grove was the best representative, scoring 93 points — 23 more than the Trojans were seeded to score. That wasn't enough to catch the host Olympians, who won the team title with 105 points.

Greenwood was fifth with 34 points and Franklin tied for sixth with 16 points. Edinburgh was eighth with 15 points, followed by Indian Creek with

14 and Whiteland 12.

Dray defended her sectional title in the 100 hurdles and added the 300 hurdle crown to her list of honors.

Borns turned in another gutsy performance with titles in the 200 and 400 meter races. Her 400 time of :59.3 is her second-best ever, despite still hurting from bursitis in her hip.

Borns and Dray combined with Christy Reed and Anji Lelenko to also win the 1600 meter relay in a school-

record time of 4:09.5.

"We're just lacking depth in that we're not able to score in some events and what hurt us tonight was not scoring in the high jump, 1600 or 3200," Tumey said. "And, the people who ran in those events had the best times of the year. Monique (Teipen) had her best time of the season in the 3200 and this was her first time under 13 (minutes)."

Franklin also outdid itself, as the Cubs weren't supposed to hit double figures, but they scored 16 points and had a school record by Tammy Ashley in the 3200, despite finishing sev-

enth.

"She had a nice performance to wrap up her career," Coach Tim Leonard said. "Really, across the board, our team had their best times of the year and it's just a great way to finish the season."

Julie Mashino and Christina Thompson advanced to the regional for the Cubs. Mashino, after scratching all three attempts in the discus where she was seeded, came back to finish fourth in the shot put. Thompson finished fourth in the 200 meter dash.
