### Grizzly Cubs track team stops Trojans' 12-year reign

Franklin coach Tim Leonard wasn't sure how all the numbers added up. But he was certain of one thing.

"It's been 12 years ... 12 years!"

Leonard said.

That's 12 years since any school except Center Grove won the girls county track and field championship.

Franklin finally ended Center Grove's reign, outscoring the Trojans 187-181 at Tuesday's county

meet at Franklin.

Indian Creek finished in third place with 85 points, followed by Greenwood (57) and Whiteland (48). It's the Cubs' first girls track title since 1988, Leonard's first year at Franklin.

Going into the final event, the 1,600-meter relay, nobody knew exactly how things stood. Edinburgh's absence put a glitch in the computerized team scoring.

"Judging by how the events played out, I thought we had a shot," Leonard said. "But I'm glad

we didn't know the score."

Franklin's 1,600-meter relay team (Morgan Goode, Jill Heminger, Ashley Gillies and Christi Shook) finished second to the Center Grove foursome (Heather Havener, Jessica Cov. Leslie Shirrell and Melissa Carlock).

"I'm so proud of these girls. They did everything we asked of them and more," Leonard said. "They ran and competed hard and did what they had to do to win."

Freshman Jessie Stringer did exactly what she needed to do in winning the high jump and long jump. She beat junior teammate Ashley Gillies by 1 inch (5-7 to 5-6) in the vertical jump and edged senior teammate Katrina Emry by one-quarter inch (15-2.25 to 15-2) in the long jump.

"I felt real good jumping tonight, but I didn't expect this since Ashley usually beats me in the high jump," Stringer said. "I'm real excited, though."

Gillies came back to win the 800meter run. Christi Shook (400 meters), Morgan Goode (300-meter hurdles) and the Cubs' 400-meter relay team (Katrina Emry, Kelly Clarkson, Jennifer Briggs and Natalie McWhorter) also won event championships. But the Cubs' depth made the biggest dif-

"I thought at the start of the season we could have a pretty good, balanced team," Leonard said. "And this is bunch of hard-working girls. I'm extremely happy for them.

The Cubs didn't grab all the county accolades, though. Center Grove's Heather Havener earned Female Athlete of the Meet honors.

The Trojans' senior sprinter won the 100-meter and 200-meter dashes, led off the winning 1,600-meter relay and anchored the Trojans to a second-place finish in the 400meter relay. She overcame a huge deficit in the shorter relay to finish just .06 second behind Franklin's winning effort.

"I just came out here with a positive attitude and tried to do my best," Havener said. "That's all

you can do."

Center Grove's Ashley Buckingham (discus), Lindsey Emerson (3,200 meters), Jessica Coy (100meter hurdles), Dayna Smart (1,600 meters) and the Trojans' 3,200-meter relay (Melissa Carlock, Kristin Loesch, Dayna Smart and Emerson) also won county titles.

Indian Creek sophomore Felicia Price, won the shot put.

## Franklin girls get to revel in championship

For years, Wheaties has proudly proclaimed its motto, The breakfast of Champions." In the future, at least in Franklin, Froot Loops may be the morning muscle mover for future Grizzly Cubs.

At Tuesday

night's 2000 Johnson County track and field championship, Franklin girls coach Tim Leonard nervously ran around his school's facilities adding this, subtracting that and encouraging his team to fight with everything they had.

One of his athletes finally said, "Coach, have a bowl of Froot Loops

and stop stressing out.'

The reason for Leonard's raised pulse was that for the past 12 years, no other county school had won it all except for Center Grove. And with 12 years of eating Trojan dust, Leonard knew his talented team had to take its shot this year.

#### Long-awaited outcome

"I'm nervous, but I know we are in the hunt," said a pacing Leonard moments before the team totals were finally announced. After the first three schools and their scores were announced, a long delay added drama to the moment. Finally, in second place came Center Grove with 180 points.

The fact that Franklin's winning score of 186 couldn't be heard over the public address system was due to the Grizzly Cubs loudly celebrating their victory, in a way that resembled a team winning a state championship.

"Center Grove is our biggest rival," said Morgan Goode.

The Franklin sophomore scored huge points all night. She finished third in the 100 high hurdles and first in the 300 low hurdles, and was on the Cubs' 4-by-400 relay team, which finished second. She also finished second in the shot

"We knew we had a chance this year because they graduated a lot, and we had a lot of people back," Goode continued. "Everyone in the county was rooting for us, and that helped a lot. We got together at practice yesterday and talked about what we had to do, and we've been focused on this for a

"We had so many PRs (personal records) tonight."

#### A real team effort

Center Grove had eight firstplace finishes to Franklin's six. Leonard talked about how this win was a total team effort, including big but unexpected third- and fourth-place finishes.

"The girls, all of them, ran their hearts out," said Leonard, after being doused with the contents of 30 water bottles after the win was an-

Leonard did talk about how huge his Cubs were in the long jump and high jump events. In the long jump, freshman Jessie Stringer outleaped Center Grove's big guns Jackie Noone and Lesley Shirriel for a county title, with teammate Katrina Emry finishing second.

Stringer came back and won the high jump, beating out teammate Ashley Gillies by an inch.

"That was huge, that was huge," said Leonard about the double 1-2 finishes. "I know I was paranoid, I know I was a basket case. But I

wouldn't trade this feeling for anything in the world."

Center Grove's Heather Havener was named Female Athlete of the Meet. The senior sprinter won the 100 and 200, and kicked off the Trojans' 1,600 relay.
